In Term 1 we investigated / covered the Biology curriculum. The following were the key components that were discussed.

Cells are derived from cells:

- How do cells multiply?
- What are the advantages and disadvantages of sexual and asexual reproduction?
- Asexual Reproduction (*mitosis*) includes:
 - Different forms (fission, budding, cloning, spores, and grafting
 - Sexual Reproduction (meiosis) is the process of sex cells formed by dividing of parent cell twice, resulting in four daughter cells
- Human Sexual Reproduction the result of humans having two parents and the offspring are not genetically identical to either parent

Requirements:

- On a large piece of poster board or media of choice (any drawing program of choice)
- Large attractive title (coloured)
- Information is contained in "chunks", typed, thorough, and accurate (check grammar and spelling)
- Colourful pictures relating to the topic (at least 8) can be from the computer , but must be coloured (no pencil visible of stick figures)
- Organized , neat layout
- Bibliography for informational sources that were used

This project is an excellent way for you to review previous material taught and demonstrate a solid understanding of the information. You will be given many classes to work on this project. Please make sure to review information from the previous terms off of the teacher blog as well as spend time researching information off of the internet before beginning the project.

You must submit rough work on a project at the end of each week for me to look at and record. I would encourage you to share your work with other classmates to look over and have them give you additional ideas.
