

- What Is The Sphinx?
- The sphinx is a cross between a lion and a human
- The Sphinx has the body of a lion and the head of a human with small differences in the face.
- The Sphinx was a spiritual guardian that is usually known to be male pharaoh that wears a headdress.
- In old Greek traditions the sphinx was believed to have wings and also the tail of a serpent.
- The sphinx was also known to devour and kill every traveler that is unable to solve the sphinx's riddle.

- -On the Great Sphinx's paw it has a pink granite slab tells a story about how the sphinx was saved from the sands of time.
- -The Great Sphinx has very little inscriptions that talk about the statue. Khafre associated himself with the statue of thee Great Sphinx.



- How Old Is The Sphinx
- -Scientists believe that The Great Sphinx is believed to be about 4,500 years old
- 4,500 years ago pharaoh khafre built the Great Sphinx out of limestone. Pharaoh Khafre also built the second pyramid of Giza.
- -The Sphinx was built during the tyrant king khafre's time as ruler of giza.
- -There has been theories that the Sphinx was built 9,000 years ago

- Material
- -Limestone (A rock made up of skeletal fragments of coral and other aquatic organisms)
 - How big is the sphinx (Height and Length)
- The Sphinx is 240 feet long (73 meters)
- The Sphinx is 66 feet tall (20 meters)



- How was was the Sphinx built
- -The Sphinx was built out of limestone and was built 4,500 years ago.
- -The limestone came off of the giza plateau known as the mokattam formation.

- The Great Sphinx was was carved instead of built out of the limestone of the

plateau
